

Emergency Panic Alarm Button

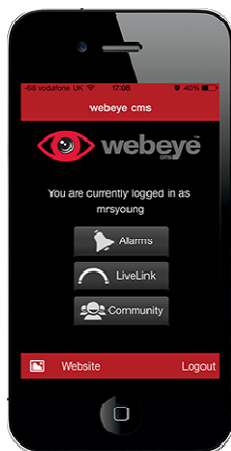


Tewkesbury School a co-educational Academy with around 1,600 students required a system to allow their front office reception and back office administration staff to summon help in the event of incidents and emergencies. After consultation with Holland Systems who had previously installed swimming pool emergency alarms in the sports centre, the Webeye Alert was selected as the best option. Unlike similar PC based systems Webeye Alert is run from an app on any compatible Android or I-Phone, making it fully portable an enabling multiple alerts to be sent so that a response will always come from a person on site and able to act.

The simple components of the system, comprised The alarm panel mounted in a convenient point and powered from a 13 amp socket, a keypad providing readout of incident locations and to enable reset. This was positioned in the main school office, and panic buttons located at the main reception desk and in the school office.



Installation was carried out during the half term holiday and was completed in 2 hours. Commissioning downloading of apps and training of staff took an additional hour. Reset keys were supplied as shown.



The cloud based administration screen was loaded onto the school system and initial users set up. The school will roll the system out to the senior leadership team over time. System tests were completed satisfactorily.

At a later date additional buttons can be installed in areas such as the sports centre reception and canteen. A lone worker alarm can also be included in the package for the safety of those working remotely on site
